Re: COVID-19 Vaccine

The IBEW Local Union 1186 is partnering with the Hawaii State Department of Health to administer the COVID-19 vaccine to our active <u>members only</u>. We were just informed yesterday that the Johnson & Johnson (J&J) vaccine has been made available to us. The J&J vaccines will be administered on <u>Saturday, April 17, 2021 at Ke`ehi Lagoon Memorial Park (Veterans' Hall)</u> <u>2685 N Nimitz Hwy, Honolulu, HI 96819 from 8:00am to 5:00pm.</u> If you are interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccine, please call our office at 808-847-5341 between the hours of 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday, to make an appointment. Appointments will be confirmed on a first-call, first-reserved basis. The deadline to make an appointment is <u>Thursday, April 15, 2021.</u>

When calling our office, our staff will go online to the Hawaii State Department of Health to reserve a time for the vaccine. Before calling, please be prepared to give our staff member your first and last name, birthdate, health insurance information (have your insurance card handy), cell number, and email address (if you have email). Once you are confirmed, you will be given an appointment time. Please do not show up more than five (5) minutes before your appointment.

Due to the limited supply of the vaccine, <u>walk-ins will not be accepted</u>. You must speak with a staff member to make an appointment. Please do not leave a message.

Please consult with your primary care physician if you are uncertain whether you should or should not take the vaccine.
